A RESOLUTION

SUPPORTING A PARTNERSHIP WITH ARC THRIFT STORES TO PRODUCE TWO CITYWIDE CLEANUP DAYS IN OCTOBER, 2013

WHEREAS, the Department of Community Resources, based on direction from City Council priorities established at the 2013 retreat, researched the possibility of hosting a Citywide cleanup event at which residents can take the opportunity to dispose of items not usually picked up by their household trash; and

WHEREAS, Arc Thrift Stores, a local nonprofit which specializes in the recycling, reuse and repurposing of household items, often thought of as refuse, has proposed a unique partnership to manage the cleanup events with limited City support and has demonstrated the capability to effectively and appropriately handle the cleanups for a cost to the City not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000); and

WHEREAS, Arc Thrift Stores' mission and core values of sustainability and inclusivity align well with important City values.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Colorado, that:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Lakewood, Colorado hereby authorizes the agreement with Arc Thrift Stores to proceed.

SECTION 2. The City Manager by way of the Community Resources Director, on behalf of the City of Lakewood is hereby authorized to proceed with partnering with Arc Thrift Stores to produce two cleanup events in October, 2013 using savings from Building Maintenance within the General Fund in the amount not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) in accordance with City Code 3.04.070.

INTRODUCED, READ AND ADOPTED by a vote of 11 for and 0 against at a regular meeting of the City Council on August 26, 2013, at 7 o'clock p.m. at Lakewood City Hall, 480 South Allison Parkway, Lakewood, Colorado.
