A RESOLUTION

SUPPORTING A GRANT APPLICATION TO JEFFERSON COUNTY OPEN SPACE REQUESTING FUNDING FOR FLOODING REMEDIATION AT BEAR CREEK LAKE PARK (BCLP)

WHEREAS, the Lakewood City Council desires to provide Lakewood citizens with safe and consistent access to amenities and services within Bear Creek Lake Park; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Community Resources is applying for a grant from Jefferson County Open Space for BCLP flood remediation; and

WHEREAS, Jefferson County Open Space requires a resolution supporting the grant application, from the governing body of the agency applying for the grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Colorado, that:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Lakewood hereby supports the grant application to Jefferson County Open Space for BCLP flood remediation.

SECTION 2. The City Council of the City of Lakewood, Colorado hereby authorizes the expenditure of matching funds necessary to meet the terms and obligations of the grant application.

SECTION 3. The project site is owned by the United States Army Corps of Engineers and is under lease to the City of Lakewood for the next 30 years.

SECTION 4. The City Council of the City of Lakewood will continue to maintain BCLP in a high quality condition and will appropriate funds for maintenance in its annual budget.

SECTION 5. If the grant is awarded, the City Council authorizes the Director of the Department of Community Resources to sign the grant agreement with Jefferson County Open Space.

SECTION 6. This resolution will be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
