A RESOLUTION

ESTABLISHING PROJECTS AND PROJECT FUNDING LEVELS IN THE 2014 ACTION PLAN FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Lakewood as an entitlement community receives Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds; and

WHEREAS, these CDBG funds are appropriated by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and the Comprehensive Planning and Research Division Manager or designee as the official representative is authorized to submit documents and assurances as may be required to administer the programs and expend the funds; and

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2014, City Council reviewed the 2014 Action Plan and recommended funding based on community needs and priorities; and

WHEREAS, the City certifies that:

- 1. The programs identified are eligible for funding and address required national objectives for the CDBG program;
- 2. Lakewood has utilized a citizen participation plan which provides for and encourages citizen participation and provides citizens with reasonable and timely access to local meetings, information and records relating to the city's use of CDBG funds; and
- 3. Lakewood has developed a Consolidated Plan which identifies Lakewood's housing, supportive service and community development priority needs for the years 2013-2017; and
- 4. Lakewood has developed an Annual Action Plan for the projected use of funds so as to principally benefit low- and moderate-income persons, address identified community development and housing needs, or aid in the prevention or elimination of slum or blight.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Colorado, that:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Lakewood hereby endorses the projects listed in attached Table A to be funded through the 2014 Community Development Block Grant.
