A RESOLUTION

ESTABLISHING PROJECTS AND PROJECT FUNDING LEVELS FOR THE 2014
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND PRESERVATION PROGRAM (CIPP)
NEIGHBORHOOD PARTICIPATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Lakewood has established the Neighborhood Participation Program; and

WHEREAS, the intent of the program is to encourage neighborhood organizations to identify their needs in their respective areas and propose projects that qualify for City resources; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution 94-74 on May 9, 1994, which revised the basic eligibility criteria and project selection process for administration of the program; and

WHEREAS, from the \$160,000 allocated to this program for projects and \$20,000 for contingencies and design in 2014, seven projects have been selected at an estimated cost of \$166,750.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lakewood that:

The City Council of the City of Lakewood hereby approves the projects listed in the following chart and directs these projects be funded from the Neighborhood Participation Program for 2014 at the amounts stated.

2014-06	Construct sidewalk missing link on south side of W. Yale Ave. near Wadsworth Blvd.	\$ 25,000
2014-08	Replace fence at basketball court at Hodgson Park with higher fence	\$ 2,000 (\$ 250)
2014-09	ADA and other improvements to restrooms at Morse Park	\$ 25,000
2014-11	Bike racks at Morse Park	\$ 5,000
2014-12	Park shelter and picnic tables at Mountair Park	\$ 30,000
2014-13	Interpretative signage at Wadsworth Station	\$ 35,000 (\$ 5,000)
