A RESOLUTION

ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM GREAT OUTDOORS COLORADO FOR REPAIRING A PORTION OF THE MULTI-USE PAVED TRAIL AT BEAR CREEK LAKE PARK (BCLP)

WHEREAS, the Lakewood City Council desires to provide Lakewood citizens with safe access to a large network of paved trails within Bear Creek Lake Park that connect to the Denver Metro and Front Range trail system; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Community Resources has applied and has been awarded a grant from Great Outdoors Colorado through the Colorado Department of Parks and Wildlife for the BCLP concrete multi-purpose paved trail repairs; and

WHEREAS, Great Outdoors Colorado requires a resolution supporting the grant from the governing body of the agency applying for the grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Colorado, that:

- SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Lakewood hereby supports the acceptance of a grant from Great Outdoors Colorado for BCLP paved trail repairs.
- SECTION 2. The City Council of the City of Lakewood hereby authorizes the expenditure of funds necessary to meet the terms and obligations of the grant.
- SECTION 3. The project site is owned by the United States Army Corps of Engineers and is under lease to the City of Lakewood for the next 25 years.
- SECTION 4. The City Council of the City of Lakewood authorizes the Department of Community Resources to continue to maintain the BCLP concrete paved trail system in a high quality condition and will appropriate funds for maintenance as needed.
- SECTION 5. The City Council authorizes the Director of the Department of Community Resources to sign the grant agreement with Great Outdoors Colorado.
- SECTION 6. This resolution will be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
