## NOTICE ELECTION SIGNS ARE REGULATED IN THE CITY OF LAKEWOOD

Dear Candidate/Committee Representative:

The City of Lakewood welcomes you to the election process! We would like to take this opportunity to let you know about the regulations for election signs. These regulations apply to all political candidates for City, County, Special District, School District, State or Federal office and supporters/opponents of ballot questions and issues.

Permits?	None Required.
Where can signs be placed?	Signs can <b>ONLY</b> be placed on private property. They are limited on private Property to a wall, window or can be Free-standing. Signs <b>CANNOT</b> be placed in or on public property, i.e. parks, benches, etc.
How large a sign is allowed?	The maximum size of a political sign Is eight (8) square feet, with a maximum Height of forty-two (42"). **Paper or Cloth banners are not allowed.** Paper signs are discouraged as they rip easily and become litter in the City.
Can signs be placed on telephone poles or in City right-of-way?	Signs in the street right-of-way, which includes signs on utility poles, are STRICTLY PROHIBITED AND WILL BE CONFISCATED BY CITY STAFF.
When must signs be removed?	Signs must be removed within five (5) days after the election.
