

US 6 Simms to Sheridan Resurfacing Project

Project Overview

On Sunday, July 14, 2013 the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) will start a resurfacing project from Simms to Sheridan. This project covers approximately 300 feet east of Simms extending 3.66 miles east to Sheridan. The project will start with resurfacing the asphalt and some minor bridge work. This resurfacing project will help maintain existing highway infrastructure and provide a smoother ride for travelers.

Martin Marietta Materials is the contractor for this \$3 million project.

Project Schedule & Details

The start date is Sunday, July 14, 2013 and is expected to last until November 2013. Normal work hours will be 8pm-5:30am Sunday through Thursday. Work will begin with removing the existing asphalt then applying new asphalt, along with cleaning the culvert and implementing permanent signage and striping.

Impacts

Travelers can expect normal speed limits and no anticipated delays. A majority of the construction work is planned during the night. The night time work will minimize the impacts to traffic.
