What could be better?

- Colfax. I'm really looking forward to FasTracks.
- Focus on the entire city for redevelopment (Sheridan)
- Less cumbersome zoning restrictions
- More affordable housing
- Make RV parking consistent with other cities (i.e., movement to behind fences, etc.). Off city streets.
- Revise RV/camper/boat parking to more vehicles to back yards, behind fences (shielded from view) and off city streets and out of front yards.
- Get Colfax filled up with multi-use developments – more restaurants.
- I would like to see zoning changes to permit more residents to keep chickens and bees.
- Better bicycle access. It's very dangerous trying to ride from 1st & Zephyr to the Belmar library, especially with children. There's no safe place to cross Alameda other than riding along Wadsworth, on sidewalks, and it is dangerous having to go through all the parking lots to get to the library. Need more bike racks.
