

## CIDER DAYS FAQ

- **Will the event still be held if it rains?**  
Cider Days will be held **rain or shine**.
- **Where do I get my tickets?**  
Cider Days tickets (and packages) are [available for advance purchase](#). Tickets will also be available on both Saturday and Sunday at all entry gates.
- **Can I re-enter if I leave the Festival?**  
Yes. Re-entry is allowed. Please make sure to receive a stamp upon exit.
- **Will food be available?**  
Yes! Cider Days hosts a variety of food vendors and food trucks with food available for purchase. Many vendors feature a specialized apple product.
- **Will apple cider be available?**  
Of course! Cider Days hosts two “Cider Booths” located inside the festival which sell both hot and cold apple cider fresh from Ela Family Farms. Guests can purchase (12oz) cups for \$2, half-gallon jugs for \$8, or (17oz) souvenir mugs (while supplies last) for \$8. Cider Booths are CASH ONLY.
- **Will there be ATMs available?**  
Yes! There will be ATMS at the Lakewood Heritage Center Visitors Center.
- **Will beer, wine and hard cider be available?**  
Yes! Patrons 21+ can purchase local craft beer and hard cider (from Glider Cider) at the [Beer Garden](#). Wine is also available from the South Jeffco Rotary Club. Patrons can purchase a separate ticket for Colorado’s largest hard cider tasting. Please see [Hard Cider Tasting](#) to learn more about the attraction.
- **Where can I park? How will I get to the festival?**  
FREE parking will be available at the Lakewood Heritage Center, Tedford Office Complex and Lakewood Cultural Center (with FREE shuttle service). Please see [Directions & Parking](#) to learn more about festival parking and shuttles.

Yes. Well behaved dogs are allowed to enter Cider Days. Dogs must be on a leash at all times. Dogs are **not** permitted on the shuttles (service animals are exempt).

- **Can we bring our own apples to press? Do you provide apples?**

Yes, you can bring your own apples to press at the festival. To accommodate all festival guests, we allow you bring no more than one bucket of apples. You can also purchase apples from Ela Family Farms inside of the festival. BUT, if you plan on pressing your own apples, be sure to bring a juice jug or growler from home to fill!
