More than two years dedicated to replace system from 1970's.

**The New Police Systems Implementation Project**

The Lakewood Police Department is embarking on a new and exciting opportunity in the world of public safety technologies designed to provide the best possible service to our citizens. Through the efforts of an interdepartmental task force we researched and selected software for Police Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD), Records Management Systems (RMS) and mobile police systems.

**Our Mission**

It is the mission of the Strategic Planning Committee of the Police Department to "identify and select through a collaborative process, an automated, fully integrated, user friendly, highly reliable, and maintainable technology solution that effectively manages data and enables the public safety systems to meet the needs of its users and the citizens of Lakewood both now and in the future."

**Intergraph Software Selection**

Within the span of the last decade, law enforcement agencies have seen an explosion of new computer-based applications designed to improve the effectiveness and efficiency of their operations. Through the ingenuity and dedication of its technical support staff, the Lakewood Police Department has tried to keep pace using "homegrown" technologies and internally developed programs.

The limitations of these systems have caused two independent consultants and the last two directors of the Information Technology Department to conclude that migration to a third party system is imperative if the Police Department wants to continue to provide the a high level of service and meet the future needs of its users. We believe IPS can provide this level of service to the Lakewood Police Department and the citizens of Lakewood.
