



To Players and Parents/Guardians:

Thank you for registering for the City of Lakewood Middle School Sports Program (MSSP). I would like to take this opportunity to provide you with additional information about the program.

Once you have registered, you will need to complete the two documents included with this letter (Player and Parent/Guardian Contract and Youth Participation Form). These forms must be completed and returned to the coach at practice.

Practices start/end dates and times are provided in the informational tri-fold. Please go to the field/gym (sport depending) on the first scheduled day of practice. The coach will be there to meet with you. The first day of practice will consist of a short meeting and can release earlier than a normal practice day. Please bring water, clothes and shoes appropriate for the sport you are playing each day.

The coach will distribute uniforms and game schedules the second week of practice. Also, all schedules, rules and paperwork can be found on our website. You can either get to it via the school website and it will have a link to the City of Lakewood MSSP page or you can go directly to www.Lakewood.org/Recreation, click on Youth Sports and then MSSP.

Buses are provided to and from away games. The bus will pick up the team after school and drop them back off at the school after the game is over. (This does not apply to cheerleading because they do not travel). You can take your child home directly from the away game, but please tell the coach!

Middle School Sports Program (MSSP) Player and Parent/Guardian Contract

1. Players must attend all practices, unless prior arrangements have been made with the coach. If prior arrangements are not made, the player will forfeit game time.
2. All players and parents/guardians are expected to demonstrate sportsman-like conduct. Failure to do so can result in ejection from the game and/or program.
3. Players and parents/guardians must remember they are representing their school as well as the City of Lakewood and must act accordingly.
4. Players and parents/guardians are expected to encourage, support and respect team members coaches and officials.
5. Players are required to remain quiet and behave on the buses provided for away games. Failure to do so can result in loss of bus privileges and/or removal from the program.
6. Players are required to behave at all schools, especially when traveling for away games. Players are not permitted to roam around the schools. Vandalism and misconduct will not be tolerated and can result in player and/or team suspensions and/or removal from the program.
7. Players and parents/guardians understand that MSSP is a **recreational** program providing opportunities for players to have fun, stay active and develop skills.
8. Any act by a player, parent/guardian and/or team that violates MSSP league expectations can result in various consequences implemented by the coach, MSSP Program Coordinator, School Administration and/or police, if necessary.
