

A RESOLUTION

APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION REGARDING THE CITY OF LAKEWOOD'S OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS, INTERSECTION MARKINGS, AND TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES ON STATE HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE CITY OF LAKEWOOD

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 29-1-203 and § 29-1-203.5 as amended, the City of Lakewood ("Lakewood") and the Colorado Department of Transportation ("CDOT") have the authority to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA);

WHEREAS, state law requires CDOT to maintain all traffic signals, crosswalk markings, stop bar markings, symbol markings, and traffic control devices on state highways within the City of Lakewood (the "Services");

WHEREAS, C.R.S. 43-2-103 authorizes Lakewood to contractually agree with CDOT to assume CDOT's responsibility for the Services;

WHEREAS, Lakewood's Traffic Maintenance Shop has the personnel, equipment, and expertise to assume responsibility for the Services; and

WHEREAS, CDOT shall compensate Lakewood annually in the amount of \$325,620 for Lakewood assuming responsibility for the Services for the IGA's term of five (5) years;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lakewood:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby finds and determines that authorizing the City Manager to enter into an IGA, attached hereto as Attachment A and incorporated herein, between the City of Lakewood and the Colorado Department of Transportation for Lakewood's provision of maintenance and repair services relating to traffic signals, crosswalk markings, stop bar markings, symbol markings, and traffic control devices on state highways within the City of Lakewood is and shall be in the best interest of the residents of the City of Lakewood, and hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into the IGA with the Colorado Department of Transportation on behalf of the City of Lakewood.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon signature following adoption.

SECTION 3. The City Manager shall be authorized to enter into amendments of the IGA subject to this Resolution without approval of the Lakewood City Council so long as such amendments are solely related to the City of Lakewood assuming responsibility for additional traffic signals, crosswalk markings, stop bar markings, symbol markings,

and traffic control devices on state highways within the City of Lakewood for additional compensation.

INTRODUCED, READ, AND ADOPTED by a vote of 10 for and 0 against at a hybrid regular meeting of the Lakewood City Council on June 9, 2025, at 7 o'clock p.m. at the Lakewood Civic Center, 480 S. Allison Parkway, Lakewood, Colorado.
